The Franklin County Court of Common Pleas has placed you in the Good Wolf Treatment Court under the supervision of the Franklin County Probation Department.

As a participant of the Good Wolf Treatment Court, you must comply with the General Rules and Conditions of Probation and Parole, as well as, all Rules, Conditions, and Policies outlined in the Treatment Court Handbook.

**RULES AND CONDITIONS**

The following rules and conditions will apply to you during the duration of the Program. Violation of any of the following rules and conditions could result in removal of the Program.

1. As a treatment court participant, you will be required to appear in Court on a regular basis as outlined in the Treatment Court Handbook, or additionally as directed to you by your Probation Officer. You must be on time for all scheduled Court appearances. Failure to attend your scheduled Court appearance may result in a bench warrant being issued for your arrest. If you cannot appear as scheduled, you must notify your Probation Officer to obtain permission from the Judge to miss court. You cannot miss court without receiving permission prior to your court date.
2. You understand that you will be required to attend and successfully complete any course of treatment, education, and/or counseling that is recommended. If you are unable to attend any scheduled treatment appointment or therapy session, you must contact your provider at least 24 hours in advance. Failure to comply with all treatment conditions imposed by the Court, Probation Department, and/or Treatment agency is a violation of the program.
3. You must attend self-help and recovery support group meetings and you must provide written proof of attendance to your treatment provider and Probation Officer prior to each Court appearance. The number of meetings you are required to attend is based on your phase progression through the program.
4. You must comply with all Drug and Alcohol components as outlined in the Participant Handbook. You must remain free from the use of alcohol, illegal drugs, or non-prescribed drugs. You understand that you will be drug tested at random throughout the program, and are aware that you may be tested on any day of the week. You should expect to be tested several times each week and must provide a urine sample when requested. You may have drug and alcohol testing during random home visits by your Probation Officer. Failure to comply will result in a positive test. Any positive test indicating the presence of any prohibited drug, drug metabolite, alcohol, or non-prescribed drug is a violation of the program.
5. You will be given two (2) hours from the initial request to provide a specimen of sufficient quantity/quality for laboratory testing. Tampering with, diluting, or failure to provide the appropriate specimen in the allotted time will result in incarceration in the Franklin County Jail, and the initiation of the violation process.
6. You may not possess, transport or consume beverages containing alcohol and shall refrain from the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illegal drugs and other controlled substances. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the residence at any time.

7. All prescription medications used by you during the program must be verified by a physician's statement and/or prescription. Use of over the counter products or medications containing alcohol is prohibited. All other use of over the counter medication must be reported to the supervising officer within 24 hours of use. You may be required to submit a list of all medications taken by co-habitants. You are not permitted to have expired and unused medication. A positive test from expired medication will still result in a violation of the program.

8. You must Comply with a Curfew and remain in your home as outlined in the Treatment Court Handbook, or as directed by your Probation Officer. The use of electronic monitoring may be used to verify this curfew. In the case in which you are placed on electronic monitoring, you must comply with the rules that coincide with EM/HA.

9. Officers of the Franklin County Probation Department shall have unconditional access to the residence during the program. Your person, property, residence, vehicle or any area associated with your program participation are subject to search at any time with or without warrant by Officers of the Franklin County Probation Department. Any items the possession of which violates these rules or the rules and conditions of probation/parole shall be subject to seizure and may be used as evidence in a violation/revocation process/hearing. You further agree that any item that violates Federal, State, or local law shall be subject to seizure and may be turned over to the appropriate law enforcement agency for possible criminal prosecution.

10. You understand and agree that you may be arrested with or without warrant following any violation of the conditions mentioned herein. You understand that this will result in your incarceration in the Franklin County Prison until a revocation hearing is held before the Court.

11. You shall continue to abide by the Probation/Parole rules/conditions of your supervision. Any violation of Probation/Parole rules/conditions shall be deemed a violation of this program.

12. Failure to comply with the rules of the Treatment Court Program will result in one or more sanctions imposed by the Judge on your following scheduled Court appearance. Also, you may receive one or more sanctions from your Probation Officer as an immediate result of a violation.

13. You shall report to the supervising probation/parole officer as per the following schedule: **You will report to the office in person every \_\_\_\_\_ between the hours of 8:30AM to 4:00PM.** You should not miss your scheduled office report for any reason.

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**I hereby acknowledge that I have read or had read to me the conditions as they relate to my participation in this program. I fully understand them, and understand that any violation of these rules and conditions may result in my incarceration in the Franklin County Prison as well as violation proceedings before the Court. Having read all three pages of these conditions, I agree to comply with them and do hereby wish to participate in the Good Wolf Treatment Court of the Franklin County Probation Department subject to all the above conditions.**
